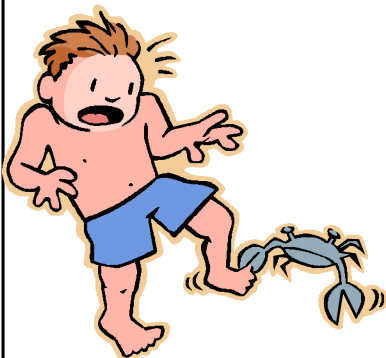

### **SHAKEDOWN CRUISE-April 14-15:**

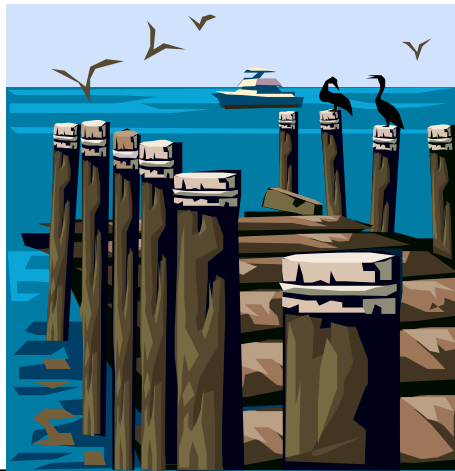

**Sunday we'll have a continental breakfast. Can't wait to see you all there.**

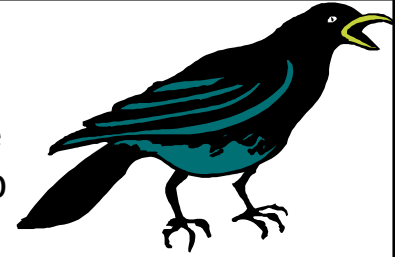
